Do you know... which Bible translation we read from?

A great sign associated with Pentecost is the gift of tongues: the Apostles started speaking in many languages and since then translating has been an essential task of the Church. In 2010 all English speaking countries received a common Missal, but for the Mass Readings, each nation's Bishops choose the Bible translation most appropriate for their country.

In Canada it is the *New Revised Standard Version*. There are many approved Bible translations in English, as well as in other languages. Which one do you use? And are there others that may appeal to you? And how can we translate our Faith in the secular language of the people around us?
